Bills for Discussion

- AB 1028 (Fong)
 - Reviewed amendments that changed the focus from tenure for PT faculty to due process.
 - The committee would like to see the bill language assert due process for all PT faculty, not just those with it in their contract.
 - The committee has particular concerns about the language “In all cases, part-time faculty assignments shall be temporary in nature, contingent on enrollment and funding, and subject to program changes, and no part-time faculty member shall have reasonable assurance of continued employment at any point, irrespective of the status, length of service, or reemployment preference of that part-time, temporary faculty member.”
 - This language perpetuates the concerns with part-time faculty inequity rather than remedies it.
 - We recommend maintaining a " Watch " position and having our advocate reach out to CFT.
- AB 934 (Berman)
 - The committee reviewed the bill and was concerned about the unintended consequences of mandatory ed plans, mandatory retroactive degree auto-awarding, and the bill's unfunded mandates.
 - The committee recommends a “Watch” position.
 - If the bill passes out of suspense, the bill can be brought back to the Legislation & Budget committee for further review.
